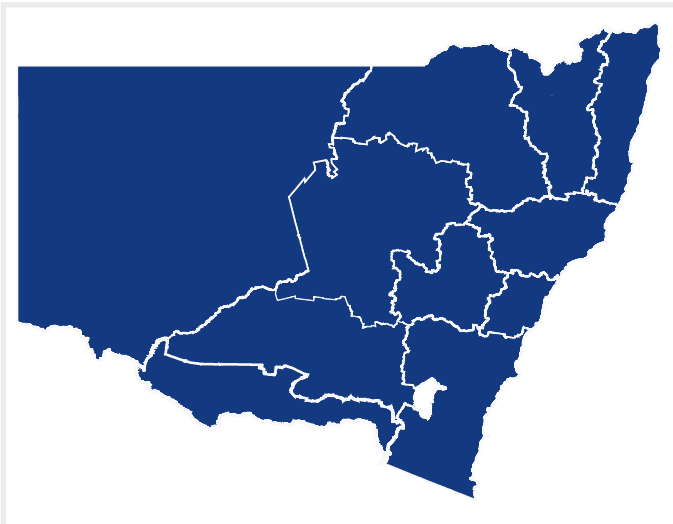


Come and be a part of a supportive and experienced team of veterinarians and Biosecurity Officers.
